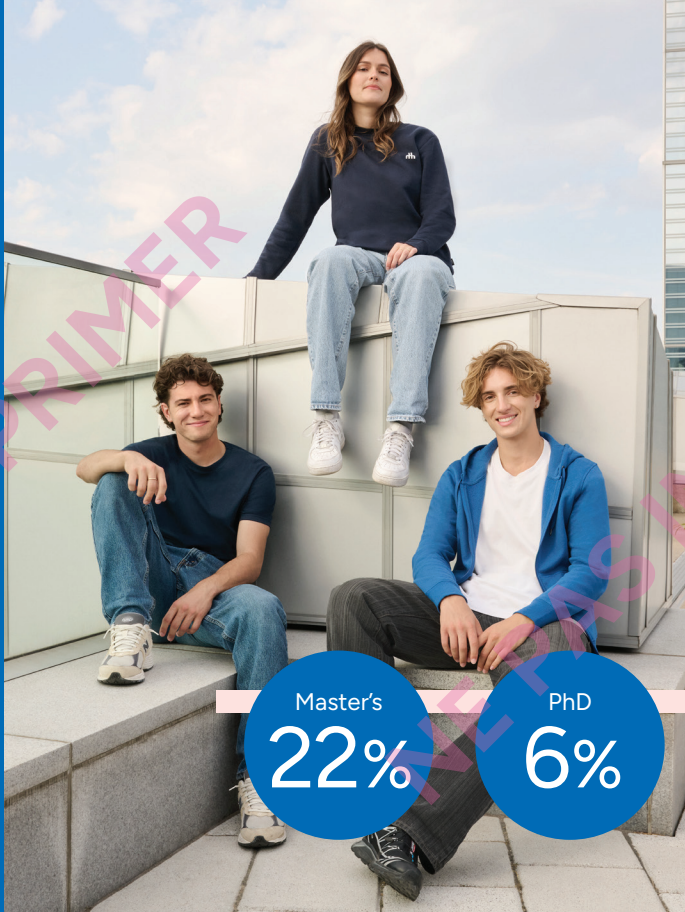
UdeM is the third largest research university in Canada and 125th in the Times Higher Education World University Rankings, which lists more than 2,000 universities.
